## Community Health Workers Training Program



On May 14, 2026, Special Olympics Bangladesh organized a Community Health Workers training program at the Dhaka South City Corporation. 25 primary healthcare workers of Dhaka South City Corporation were trained at the Shitalakshya Hall of the DSCC Bhaban. This is the second phase of the Community Health Worker Program. In the first phase 25 health care workers were trained.

This special training workshop focused on identifying unrecognized children with special needs in society, registering them in the Special Olympics Database, training parents and siblings who care for them, providing health protection training, and assisting them in accessing healthcare services at government service centers for various physical conditions.



The workshop was chaired by Dr. Nishat Parvin, Chief Health Officer of Dhaka South City Corporation and Clinical Director of Special Olympics Bangladesh. In addition, Mr. Faruqul Islam, National Director of Special Olympics Bangladesh, Clinical Board Director Dr. Zafar Ahmed, and three other doctors from Dhaka South City Corporation provided training to the participants.
